Animal Intake


Last year we took in 1108 animals. This includes: 562 Freshwater Fish, 2 Saltwater Fish, 523 Herptiles (including arthropods and terrestrial gastropods), 5 Birds and 14 Small Mammals.


Animal Outcomes

Last year we adopted out 724 animals, transferred 41 animals to different adoptions facilities, transferred 9 animals to wildlife rehabilitators, 62 animals passed away or were euthanized by the DNR, and 272 animals were still available for adoption.

Finances
