Vehicle

We were awarded a grant by Petco Love Foundation in the amount of \$35,000 for our surrender events. We can purchase a vehicle with these funds as well. Ideally, we would get a cargo van with custom decals for sponsors (this is part of the grant), customized interior for securing bins of animals, car play installed for navigation/safety. Leftover funds should be used to help pay for the surrender events.

Capturing useful information on intakes

Discussed ways to capture useful information on intakes. Info such as favorite foods, habits, likes, dislikes and that sort of thing could be posted on the website and on kennel card.
